"Flight of the **Bumblebee**" is an orchestral interlude written by Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov (1844–1908) for his opera The Tale of Tsar **Saltan**, composed in 1899–**1900**. Its composition is

chaotic and rapidly  
changing flying pattern of  
a bumblebee. Despite the  
piece being a rather  
incidental part of the  
opera, it is today one of  
the more familiar  
classical works because of  
its frequent use in  
popular culture.**
